Summary:	On 01 August 2019, Telefónica S.A., the Registry Operator for .telefonica, notified ICANN that it wished to terminate the RA citing its own business needs. On 15 October 2019, ICANN made a preliminary determination that operation of the .telefonica gTLD need not be transitioned to a successor Registry Operator.
	On 10 December 2019, after a 30-day period for comments by interested parties, ICANN made a Final Determination to terminate the .telefonica Registry Agreement and revoke the TLD's delegation from the Root Zone.
